- Support necessary partner facilitation and engagement activities to meet the hub redevelopment timelines and any deliverables
- Coordinates and convenes Governance Meeting with senior leaders from Anchor Partner tenants
- Convenes and provides oversight and leadership to the Hub Strategic Planning and Operational Planning processes and implementation and manages one direct report involved with these projects
- Convenes and provides leadership and oversight to the Golden Mile Impact Network project
- Actively participates in the Management team meetings and initiatives including, but not limited to resource development, organizational capacity building, training and new projects
- Works with the Director of Finance to ensure that the hub is financially stable and on track
- Represents WWCC at external/internal networks/forums/committees as needed
- Ensures that all WWCC policies and procedures are followed
- Performs other work as requested by the Executive Director or designate
- Troubleshoots problems and issues as required
